

“footway”	means a way comprised in a highway which also comprises a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a right of way on foot only;
“the footway/cycle track”	means the segregated footway/cycle track adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A5111 from its junction with West Service Road for a distance of 210 metres, in a northerly direction;
“the works period”	means the period starting at 19.00 hours on Tuesday 11th February 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a link road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any person using a pedal cycle to enter or proceed in the footway/cycle track.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway/cycle track.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.

8. The provisions of articles 4 and 5 shall not apply to any person -

- (a) engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activity; or
- (b) engaged in activity connected with the said works.
