ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A36 Trunk Road (Deptford Junction to Wilton, Salisbury)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *11th February 2014*

Coming into force - - - *17th February 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road (“the A36”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads between Deptford and Wilton in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Deptford Junction to Wilton, Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 17th February 2014.

2. In this Order –

“the A36” means (i) the A36 southbound between the tip of the nosing of the southbound exit slip road leading to the A303 westbound at the Deptford Junction and the western edge of Wilton Roundabout, Salisbury; and (ii) the A36 northbound between the western edge of Wilton Roundabout, Salisbury and the tip of the nosing of the northbound exit slip road leading to the A303 westbound at the Deptford Junction;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading from the A303 westbound to the A36 southbound at the Deptford Junction;

“the tip of the nosing” means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

“the works” mean resurfacing, road marking, drainage repairs, drainage installation, geotechnical repairs, site survey works and general maintenance activities;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Wednesday 19th February 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the A36 and the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction or with the permission of a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes;
- (d) vehicles proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A36.
