ROAD TRAFFIC

The A64 Trunk Road (Brambling Fields Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made	-	13th February 2014
Coming into force	-	20th February 2014

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A64 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Ryedale, in the County of North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads should be prohibited because drainage and routine maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A64 Trunk Road (Brambling Fields Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 20th February 2014.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 21st February 2014 and ending when the said works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A64 Trunk Road eastbound exit slip road at Brambling Fields Interchange.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
