## ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A3(M) Motorway (Junction 3) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

*Made - - - - 29th December 2014* 

Coming into force - - 17th January 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3(M) Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A3(M) Motorway (Junction 3) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 17th January 2015.

#### 2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the A3(M) Motorway in the County of Hampshire;

- "a slip road" means –
- (i) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway to the B2150 (Hulbert Road) at Junction 3, or
- (ii) the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the motorway from the B2150 (Hulbert Road) at Junction 3;

"works" means signalisation, road markings, electrical connections, vegetation clearance, provision of CCTV and ADSL telephone communications, resurfacing and all associated work;

- "a works period" means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 19th January 2015 or on any subsequent day until 16th July 2016.
- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;

(c)	anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic office	cei

(d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
