ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A45 Trunk Road (Brackmills to Billing, Northamptonshire)
(Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *7th February 2014*

Coming into force - - *14th February 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Brackmills and Billing, in the County of Northamptonshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Brackmills to Billing, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Friday 14th February 2014.

2. In this Order:

| “Brackmills Interchange” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its roundabout junction with Caswell Road; |
| “Billing Interchange” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its roundabout junction with the A5076 Great Billing Way and Crow Lane; |
| “Barnes Meadow Interchange” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its roundabout junction with the A428 Bedford Road and Rushmere Road; |
| “the trunk road” | means –

i) the eastbound carriageway of the A45 from a point 200 metres east of the junction leading from Brackmills Interchange, to a point 200 metres east of the junction leading to Billing Interchange; and |

- ii) the westbound carriageway of the A45 from a point 400 metres east of the junction leading to Billing Interchange, to a point 200 metres west of the junction leading to Barnes Meadow Interchange;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 17th February 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or special forces purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
