## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

# The M1 Motorway (Junction 2, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 17th February 2014

Coming into force - - 8th March 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 2, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 8th March 2014 and shall apply for a period of eighteen months.

#### 2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M1 Motorway in the London Borough of Barnet;

"a slip road" means -

- (i) the road leading from the A1 (Great North Way) to the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 2, or
- (ii) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway to the A1 (Great North Way) at Junction 2;

"works" mean Transport for London refurbishment works on the A1 Sunny Gardens footbridge; and

"a works period" means a period of -

- (i) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 8th March 2014 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 9th March 2014 or on any subsequent Sunday,
- (iii) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 10th March 2014 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 14th March 2014 or on any subsequent Friday, or

until 7th September 2015.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
  - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
  - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
