ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Camborne to Hayle) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - 18th February 2014

Coming into force - - 21st February 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and two of those connecting roads between Camborne and Hayle in Cornwall should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Camborne to Hayle) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 21st February 2014.

2. In this Order –

"the A30" means (i) the A30 westbound between the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at the Treswithian Junction, Camborne and the eastern edge of Loggans Moor Roundabout, near Hayle; and (ii) the A30 eastbound between the eastern edge of Loggans Moor Roundabout, near Hayle, and the tip of the nosing of the eastbound entry slip road at the Treswithian Junction, Camborne;

"the slip roads" mean the westbound entry slip road and the eastbound exit slip road at the A30 Treswithian Junction, Camborne:

"tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean drainage works including filter stone renewal;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Sunday 23rd February 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

"a works period" means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Monday 24th February 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the A30.

- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the A30 and the slip roads.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes or anything done at the direction or with the permission of a constable.
- **6.** The provisions of article 4 shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the said works, for traffic officer purposes or for winter maintenance purposes.
- **7.** No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
