# The M5 Motorway (Junctions 11A-12) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013 Variation Order 2014

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section $14(1)(a)$ of, and paragraph $27(1)$ of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and regulation 16(2) of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(b):

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junctions 11A-12) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013 Variation Order 2014 and shall come into force on 21st February 2014.
2. The M5 Motorway (Junctions 11A-12) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order $2013(\mathbf{c})$ is hereby varied by substituting, for the definition "the hard shoulder" in article 2, the following definition:
'"the hard shoulder" means the hard shoulder within the meaning of regulation 3(1)(e) of the Regulations which is adjacent to the first length of the M5; ' and by substituting, for article 3(f), the following article:

- (f) cause or permit any vehicle with an overall width exceeding 2 metres to enter or proceed in any lane other than the left hand running lane of the first length of the M5.'
