ROAD TRAFFIC

The M11 Motorway (Junctions 10 to 8) Southbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *13th January 2014*

Coming into force - - *20th January 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M11 Motorway (“the M11”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway and on some of those connecting roads, in the County of Essex, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M11 Motorway (Junctions 10 to 8) Southbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 20th January 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the tip of the nosing” means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the motorway;

“the motorway” means the southbound carriageway of the M11 –

(a) from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 10 to the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 8, and

(b) from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 9A to its merge point with the southbound carriageway of the M11 at Junction 9;

“a slip road” means the entry slip road to the southbound carriageway of the M11 at Junction 9A and Junction 10;

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 22:00 hours on Wednesday 22nd January 2014 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform;
