### ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A5 Trunk Road (Weedon, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 17th February 2014

Coming into force - - 24th February 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Northamptonshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Weedon, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 24th February 2014.

#### 2. In this Order:

"pedal cycle" has the meaning given in regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs

Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"cycle track" means a way constituting or comprised in a highway, being

a way over which the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on pedal

cycles with or without a right of way on foot;

"footway" means a way comprised in a highway which also comprises

a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a

right of way on foot only;

"the trunk road" means the –

a) northbound carriageway of the A5 from a point 145 metres north of the junction with the A45, to a point 1 kilometre north of the junction with the A45; and

b) southbound carriageway of the A5 from a point 1 kilometre north of the junction with the A45, to a point 145 metres north of the junction of the A45;

"the footway/cycle track" means the footway/cycle track adjacent to the northbound

carriageway of the A5 from its junction with the A45, to a

point 240 metres north of the junction with the A45;

"the works period" means the period starting at 08:00 hours on Sunday 2nd

March 2014 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7 no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the trunk road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any person using a pedal cycle to enter or proceed in the footway/cycle track.
- **5**. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway/cycle track.
- **6.** The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - 7. The provisions of
    - a. article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle
      - i. being used for special forces purposes;
      - ii. being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
      - iii. proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
    - b. article 4 and 5 shall not apply to
      - i. any pedestrian engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activities;
      - ii. any pedestrian acting under the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
      - iii. personnel engaged in the said works; and
      - iv. any pedestrian proceeding to and from premises which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
