ROAD TRAFFIC

The A13 Trunk Road (Lakeside Junction – North Stifford Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

 10th March 2014

 Coming into force
 29th March 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A13 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A13 Trunk Road (Lakeside Junction – North Stifford Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 29th March 2014.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A13 Trunk Road in the Borough of Thurrock;

"the length of trunk road" means the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road from a point 700 metres west of Lakeside Junction (A126) to North Stifford Interchange (A1012);

"works" mean resurfacing, retexturing, road marking, stud reinstatement and all associated work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of-

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Thursday 3rd April 2014 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 4th April 2014 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 5th April 2014 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 6th April 2014 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 28th September 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
 - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
 - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
