ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M1 Motorway and the M18 Motorway (Thurcroft Interchange)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *6th March 2014*

Coming into force - *16th March 2014*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway and the M18 Motorway and connecting roads, in the District of Rotherham, in the County of South Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because gantry sign works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway and the M18 Motorway (Thurcroft Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 16th March 2014.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 17th March 2014 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the:

- (i) M18 Motorway southbound carriageway from the nose of the exit slip road at Junction 1 (Bramley) to the nose of the M1 Motorway southbound entry slip road at Junction 32 (Thurcroft), a distance of 6119 metres;
- (ii) M18 Motorway southbound entry slip road at Junction 1; or
- (iii) the link road connecting the M18 Motorway southbound carriageway with the M1 Motorway northbound carriageway at Thurcroft (the M1 Motorway at Junction 32).

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
