## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A38 Trunk Road (Ashburton) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014

Made		-	-	10th March 2014
Coming in	to force	-	-	13th March 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Ashburton in the County of Devon should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Ashburton) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 13th March 2014.

2. In this Order –

"the A38" means the westbound carriageway of the A38 at Ashburton from the splitter island at the Whistley Hill junction to the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at the Peartree junction;

"tip of the nosing" means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean the repair of a bridge parapet at Chuley Underbridge;

"the works period" means the period starting at 16:00 hours on Friday 14th March 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the A38.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

**5.** No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
