ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (Junctions 6 – 6A) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 17th March 2014

5th April 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that motorway and on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junctions 6 - 6A) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 5th April 2014.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M1 Motorway in the County of Hertfordshire;

Coming into force - -

"the length of carriageway" means the northbound carriageway of the motorway between Junction 6 (A405) near Bricket Wood and Junction 6A (M25 Junction 21);

"the slip road" means the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 6 (A405) near Bricket Wood;

"works" mean resurfacing, road markings, structural inspection, traffic detection equipment replacement and maintenance and all associated carriageway works on the motorway; and

"a works period" means a period of -

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 7th April 2014 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 11th April 2014 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 12th April 2014 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 13th April 2014 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 4th October 2015.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway or the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
 - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
 - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
