## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M61 Motorway (Junction 5 Southbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made - - - - 21st January 2015

Coming into force - - 8th February 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M61 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of Bolton in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M61 Motorway (Junction 5 Southbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 8th February 2015.
- 2. In this Order;

"the motorway" means the M61 Motorway;

"works" means CCTV, signage and maintenance works;

"the works period" means periods overnight between 2100 hours and 0500 hours (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturday and Sunday mornings) during a period starting on Monday 9th February 2015 and ending on Tuesday 31st March 2015. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the slip road" means the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 5.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as
shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used
for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used
in connection with the works, for winter maintenance purposes or by traffic officers, or to any
vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in
uniform.
