## ROAD TRAFFIC

# The M6 and M69 Motorways (M6 Junction 2) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made - - - - 2nd February 2015

Coming into force - - 9th February 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway ("the M6"), the M69 Motorway ("the M69") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M6 and M69 Motorways (M6 Junction 2) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Monday 9th February 2015.

### 2. In this Order -

"the roundabout" means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout

junction of the A4600/B4065 Hinckley Road, A46 and the

slip roads leading to and from the M6 (Junction 2);

"the slip road" means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway

of the B4065 Hinckley Road and to the northbound

carriageway of the M69 from the roundabout.

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 16th

February 2015 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
  - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
  - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by, or with the permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
