ROAD TRAFFIC

The M3 Motorway (Junction 4 – Kitsmead Lane, Carriageways) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M3 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that motorway because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M3 Motorway (Junction 4 – Kitsmead Lane, Carriageways) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 15th February 2015 and shall apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M3 Motorway in the County of Surrey;

"a length of carriageway" means both carriageways of the motorway from Junction 4 (A331) to Kitsmead Lane overbridge (at marker post 37/3) west of Junction 2 (M25);

"the Regulations" means regulation 16(2) of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(**b**);

"a hard shoulder" means the hard shoulder, within the meaning of regulation 3(1)(e) of the Regulations, which is adjacent to a length of carriageway;

"works" mean essential carriageway repairs and associated works on the motorway; and

"a works period" means a period of -

- (i) 6¹/₂ hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 15th February 2015 or on any subsequent Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 16th February 2015 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (iii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 20th February 2015 or on any subsequent Friday, or
- (iv) 9 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 21st February 2015 or on any subsequent Saturday,

until Sunday 14th February 2016.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on a length of carriageway or a hard shoulder.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations $2011(\mathbf{a})$ when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

5. During a works period, the provisions of regulations 5 and (insofar as it relates to a vehicle being driven) 9 of the Regulations are hereby suspended in respect of a hard shoulder, at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
