ROAD TRAFFIC

The A19 Trunk Road (Howden Interchange to Coast Road Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made	-	-	5th February 2015
Coming into force	-	-	18th February 2015

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of North Tyneside, in the County of Northumberland, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway should be prohibited because installation of a traffic monitoring unit site and traffic loop detector works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (Howden Interchange to Coast Road Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 18th February 2015.

2. In this Order:-

"the A19" means the A19 Trunk Road;

"the northbound carriageway" means the A19 northbound carriageway from the nose of the northbound exit slip road at the A193 Howden Interchange to its junction with the circulatory carriageway of the A19 at the A1058 Coast Road Interchange, a distance of approximately 1287 metres;

"the southbound carriageway" means the A19 southbound carriageway from its junction with the circulatory carriageway at Coast Road Interchange to the nose of the southbound entry slip road at Howden Interchange, a distance of approximately 1287 metres;

"a slip road" means the A19 southbound exit and northbound entry slip roads at Howden Interchange;

"the works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Thursday 19th February 2015 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound carriageway, the southbound carriageway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
