CIVIL AVIATION

The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Guildford) Regulations 2015

Made - - - - 26th March 2015

Coming into force - - 27th June 2015

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Guildford, Surrey, by reason of a flying display associated with the Armed Forces Day 2015 national event that is scheduled to take place on 27th June 2015.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Guildford) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 27th June 2015.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) the times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time(**b**).

Restricted airspace

- **3.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1130 hours and 1630 hours on 27th June 2015 no aircraft is to fly below 2,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 1.5 nautical miles whose centre is at 511445N 0003342W.
 - (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft—
 - (a) making an approach to, or departure from, Farnborough Airport under the control of Farnborough Air Traffic Control,
 - (b) flying in accordance with a clearance issued by Royal Air Force Odiham Air Traffic Control, or
 - (c) flying in accordance with the permission of the Flying Display Director of National Armed Forces Day (National Event) 2015.

⁽b) In these Regulations Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Guildford, Surrey, for a flying display associated with Armed Forces Day 2015 that is scheduled to take place there on 27th June 2015. A large number of people are expected to attend the event at which military aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres. The Civil Aviation Authority's Safety and Airspace Regulation Group (SARG) considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the display for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which for the purpose of these Regulations is one hour behind British Summer Time.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
