The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Trooping the Colour) Regulations 2015

Made - - - - *5th March 2015*

Coming into force - - *13th June 2015*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Central London by reason of the Trooping the Colour ceremony that is scheduled to take place on 13th June 2015.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Trooping the Colour) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 13th June 2015.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) the times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time^(b).

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 0900 hours and 1200 hours on 13th June 2015 no aircraft is to fly below 2,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 2.5 nautical miles whose centre is at 513030N 0000731W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft—

- (a) flying in the service of the Metropolitan Police Service,
- (b) flying in the service of the Helicopter Emergency Medical Services,
- (c) making an approach to Runway 09 at London City Airport at a height of not less than 1,500 feet above mean sea level and to the east of a line running true north to true south through 513030N 0000514W (London Bridge),
- (d) making an approach to or departure from the London Heliport, Battersea, to the west of a line running true north to true south through 512852N 0001018W (Battersea Bridge), whilst under the control of London Heliport Air Traffic Control, or

(a) S.I. 2009/3015, to which there are amendments that are not relevant to these Regulations.

(b) In these Regulations Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

- (e) flying with the permission of Chief Inspector Aiden Gibson of the Metropolitan Police Service.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in the airspace above central London during the Trooping the Colour Ceremony that is scheduled to take place there on 13th June 2015. In view of the high profile of this event and the presence of Her Majesty the Queen, other members of the Royal Family and other VIPs, the Home Office and the Civil Aviation Authority's Safety and Airspace Regulation Group consider that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the event for reasons of security and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which for the purpose of these Regulations is one hour behind British Summer Time.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
