ROAD TRAFFIC

The A19 Trunk Road (Osmotherley) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made - - - - 12th February 2015

Coming into force - 22nd February 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road, in the District of Hambleton, in the County of North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be prohibited because local authority works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (Osmotherley) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 22nd February 2015.
 - 2. In this Order: -

"the A19" means the A19 Trunk Road:

"the central reservation" means that part of the A19 which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of traffic using that road;

"the works period" means the period starting at 07:30 hours on Monday 23rd February 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed;

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A19 at its junctions with Leake Lane or Cotcliffe Bank.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, no person shall, during the works period, cause of permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gap in the central reservation opposite its junctions with Leake Lane or Cotcliffe bank.
- **5.** The provisions articles 3 and 4 of this Order apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.

and nothing in article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the A19 to or from pren	nises
and property which is accessible for that vehicle, from, and only from, that road.
