ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (Junctions 20 to 21, Leicestershire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway, in the County of Leicestershire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junctions 20 to 21, Leicestershire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Monday 23rd February 2015.

2. In this Order –

"the motorway"	 means – a) the northbound carriageway of the M1 from a point 2700 metres south of the centreline of Station Road overbridge, Dunton Basset, to a point 500 metres north of that centreline; and 	
	 b) the southbound carriageway of the M1 from a point 2700 metres north of the centreline of Station Road overbridge, Dunton Basset,, to a point 500 metres south of that centreline; 	
"the works period"	means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 2nd March 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- a) being used for special forces purposes;
- b) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- c) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
