ROAD TRAFFIC

The A303 Trunk Road and A36 Trunk Road (Deptford Junction Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made - - - - 18th February 2015

Coming into force - - 25th February 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A303 Trunk Road ("the A303"), the A36 Trunk Road ("the A36") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads at the Deptford Junction in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A303 Trunk Road and A36 Trunk Road (Deptford Junction Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 25th February 2015.

2. In this Order -

"the slip roads" mean (i) the A36 northbound exit slip road leading to the A303 eastbound at Deptford and (ii) The A303 eastbound exit slip road leading to the A36 at Deptford village

"the works" mean installation of vehicle detection loops;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Friday 27th February 2015 and at the same time on subsequent days ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
