ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Ranby, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made - - - - *2nd March 2015*
Coming into force - - *9th March 2015*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road ("the A1"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Ranby in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Ranby, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Monday 9th March 2015.

2. In this Order –

"the works period" means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 16th March 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A1 situated 1.3 kilometres north of the junction with the slip road leading from the dumbbell roundabout junction of the A57, A614 Blyth Road and the B6420 Mansfield Road, at Apleyhead.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- c) being used in connection with the said works.
