ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junctions 4 to 3, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made - - - - 9th March 2015

Coming into force - - 16th March 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway ("the M6") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of the M6 and some of those connecting roads, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junctions 4 to 3, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Monday 16th March 2015.
- 2. In this Order –

"the motorway"

means -

- a) the eastbound carriageway of the M6 from the junction with the exit slip road at Junction 4, to the junction with the entry slip road at Junction 3;
- b) the westbound carriageway of the M6 from the junction with the exit slip road at Junction 3, to the junction with the entry slip road at Junction 4;

"a slip road"

means the slip roads leading -

- a) to the eastbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 4·
- b) from the eastbound carriageway of the M6 to Corley Motorway Service Area;
- c) to the eastbound carriageway of the M6 from Corley Motorway Service Area;
- d) from the eastbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 3;

- e) to the westbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 3;
- f) from the westbound carriageway of the M6 to Corley Motorway Service Area;
- g) to the westbound carriageway of the M6 from Corley Motorway Service Area;
- h) from the westbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 4:

"a link road"

means the link roads leading -

- a) from the westbound carriageway of the M6 to the northbound carriageway of the M42;
- b) from the westbound carriageway of the M6 to the southbound carriageway of the M42;
- c) from the southbound carriageway of the M42 to the eastbound carriageway of the M6; and
- d) from the northbound carriageway of the M42 to the eastbound carriageway of the M6.

"the works period"

means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 23rd March 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the motorway, a slip road or a link road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
 - a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - c) being used in connection with the said works or by, or with the permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
