ROAD TRAFFIC

The M42 Motorway (Junctions 5 to 4, Solihull) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made - - - - 9th March 2015

Coming into force - - 16th March 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway ("the M42") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and on one of those connecting roads, in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M42 Motorway (Junctions 5 to 4, Solihull) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Monday 16th March 2015.

2. In this Order -

"the motorway" means the southbound carriageway of the M42 from its

junction with the exit slip road at Junction 5 to its junction

with the entry slip road at Junction 4;

"the slip road" means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway

of the M42 at Junction 5;

"the works period" means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 23rd

March 2015 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works or by, or with the permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
