ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Muckley Corner, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Coming into force			-	-23rd March 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Muckley Corner in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Muckley Corner, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Monday 23rd March 2015.

2. In this Order –	
"Muckley Corner Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A5, A461 and Hall Lane;
"the trunk road"	means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A5 between the roundabout junction with Hanney Hay Road and Barracks Lane and Muckley Corner Roundabout;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Wednesday 25th March 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at the junction with Lion's Den.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- c) being used in connection with the said works; or
- d) proceeding to or from premises which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
