ROAD TRAFFIC

The A43 Trunk Road (Ardley, Oxfordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made---20th March 2015Coming into force--27th March 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A43 Trunk Road ("the A43"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Ardley in the County of Oxfordshire, should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A43 Trunk Road (Ardley, Oxfordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Friday 27th March 2015.

2. In this Order:

"Cherwell Junction"	means the junction of the A43 and the slip roads leading to (i) Cherwell Valley motorway service area, and (ii) the southbound carriageway of the M40 at Junction 10 of the M40;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Saturday 28th March 2015 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this Order.

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from the southbound carriageway of the A43 onto the northbound carriageway of the A43 at Cherwell Junction.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
