The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bethnal Green) Regulations 2015

Made		at 02.00 on 11th August 2015
Coming into force -	-	with immediate effect

The Secretary of State for a reason affecting the public interest deems it necessary to restrict flying in the vicinity of the area specified in the Schedule by reason of an emergency having arisen in that area.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 161 of the Air Navigation Order $2009(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bethnal Green) Regulations 2015 and come into force with immediate effect.

Restricted airspace

2. No aircraft is to fly below a height of 3,950 feet above mean sea level over the area specified in Column 1 of the Schedule, being an area bounded by a circle of the radius specified in Column 2 and centred on the position specified in Column 3.

These Regulations do not apply to aircraft flying in accordance with directions given by the Metropolitan Police who may be contacted on 0208 345 4888.
