The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southport) (Amendment) Regulations 2015

Made	-	-	14th August 2015
Coming into force	-	-	19th September 2015

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Southport, Merseyside by reason of a flying display that is scheduled to take place there on 19th and 20th September 2015. The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order $2009(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southport) (Amendment) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 19th September 2015.

Amendment

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southport) Regulations 2015(**b**) are amended as follows.

3. In regulation 3(1), for "1700 hours" substitute "1730 hours".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southport) Regulations 2015 (S.I. 2015/1097) ("the principal Regulations"). The amendment amends the end time of the flying display that is scheduled to take place on 19th and 20th September 2015.
