The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Overton) (Revocation) Regulations 2015

The Secretary of State previously decided that it was necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Overton, Hampshire by reason of the intended holding of a flying display which was scheduled to take place there at the Carfest South festival between the 28th and 30th August 2015.

The flying display having now been cancelled, the Secretary of State no longer deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Overton, Hampshire and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order $2009(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Overton) (Revocation) Regulations 2015 and come into force with immediate effect.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Overton) Regulations 2015(b) are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations revoke, with immediate effect, the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Overton) Regulations 2015 (S.I.2015/1365) which imposed restrictions of flying in airspace in the vicinity of Overton, Hampshire, in the period from 28th to 30th August 2015, the flying display having been cancelled.
