**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Eastbourne)
Regulations 2015**

Made - - - - - *19th February 2015*

Coming into force - - - *13th August 2015*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Eastbourne, East Sussex, by reason of flying displays that are scheduled to take place during the period from 13th to 16th August 2015.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Eastbourne) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 13th August 2015.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(2) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time^(b).

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (3) and during the periods specified in paragraph (2), no aircraft is to fly below 5,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by straight lines joining successively the following points—

- (a) 504047N 0001603E,
- (b) 504619N 0002508E,
- (c) 505038N 0001835E,
- (d) 504506N 0000930E, and
- (e) 504047N 0001603E.

(2) The periods referred to in paragraph (1) are—

- (a) between 1100 hours and 1600 hours on 13th August 2015,
- (b) between 1100 hours and 2000 hours on 14th August 2015, and
- (c) between 1100 hours and 1700 hours on 15th and 16th August 2015 respectively.

(a) S.I. 2009/3015, to which there are amendments that are not relevant to these Regulations.

(b) In these Regulations Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

(3) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the Eastbourne Airshow flying display director.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Eastbourne, East Sussex, on the occasion of the Airbourne 2015 Airshow which will take place at Eastbourne between 13th and 16th August 2015. A large number of civil and military aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the event. Accordingly the Civil Aviation Authority's Safety and Airspace Regulation Group considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the displays for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(3), the Eastbourne Airshow flying display director may be contacted on telephone 07979 593941.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(2) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which for the purpose of these Regulations is one hour behind British Summer Time.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
