ROAD TRAFFIC

The A41 Trunk Road (Chester Road) Northbound and Southbound Carriageways (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A41 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on sections of that trunk road in Cheshire West and Chester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A41 Trunk Road (Chester Road) Northbound and Southbound Carriageways (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 8th March 2015.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A41 Trunk Road;

"works" means survey works on the trunk road;

"the works period" means periods overnight between 2000 hours and 0700 hours (ending at 0500 on weekday morings) during a period starting on Monday 9th March 2015 and ending on Sunday 22nd March 2015. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road into Hooton Road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road into Hooton Green.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
