## **PUBLIC SERVICE PENSIONS**

# The Public Service Pensions Act 2013 (Judicial Offices) Order 2015

Made - - - - 5th March 2015
Laid before Parliament 10th March 2015
Coming into force - - 1st April 2015

The Lord Chancellor and Secretary of State make this Order in exercise of the power conferred by paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the Public Service Pensions Act 2013(1).

#### **Citation and Commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Service Pensions Act 2013 (Judicial Offices) Order 2015 and comes into force on 1st April 2015.

#### Interpretation

**2.** For the purposes of this Order, an office is "held on a salaried basis" if service in that office is remunerated by payment of a salary.

#### **Judicial Offices**

**3.** A person who holds one of the offices specified in the Schedule is a member of the judiciary for the purposes of the Public Service Pensions Act 2013.
