ROAD TRAFFIC

The A259 Trunk Road (King Offa Way) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made - - - - - *12th January 2015*

Coming into force - - - - - *31st January 2015*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (King Offa Way) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 31st January 2015.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of carriageway” means both carriageways of the A259 (King Offa Way) between points 648 metres west and 563 metres east of Chantry Lane underbridge (B2182);

“works” mean resurfacing, reinstallation of studs and detector loops and all associated works; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 2nd February 2015 or on any subsequent day until 30th July 2016.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
