The Brucellosis Incentive and Pig Industry Restructuring (Non-Capital Grant) Revocations (England) Scheme 2015

The Secretary of State makes this Scheme in exercise of the powers conferred by section 106(1), and (10) of the Agriculture Act 1970(1) and by section 1(1) and (2) of the Farm Land and Rural Development Act 1988(2) and with the consent of the Treasury.

Citation, commencement and application

1.—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Brucellosis Incentive and Pig Industry Restructuring (Non-Capital Grant) Revocations (England) Scheme 2015comes into force on 1st July 2015.

(2) This Scheme applies to England only.
