**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Wimbledon)  
(Revocation) Regulations 2016**

*Made - - - - at 09.45 hours on 11th July 2016*

*Coming into force - - with immediate effect*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Wimbledon, London Borough of Merton by reason of the intended holding of the Wimbledon Lawn Tennis Championships.

The Lawn Tennis Championships having now ended, the Secretary of State no longer considers it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in that area and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Wimbledon) (Revocation) Regulations 2016 and come into force with immediate effect.

**Revocation of Regulations**

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Wimbledon) Regulations 2016(b) are revoked.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations revoke The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Wimbledon) Regulations 2016 which imposed restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Wimbledon on each day beginning with 25th June 2016 and ending on 11th July 2016, as a result of Wimbledon Lawn Tennis Championships having ended.
