ROAD TRAFFIC

The M42 and M6 Toll Motorways (Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2016

Made - - - - 17th June 2016

Coming into force - - 24th June 2016

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway (“the M42”) and the M6 Toll Motorway (“the M6 Toll”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of those motorways, between Coleshill and Water Orton, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The M42 and M6 Toll Motorways (Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2016 and shall come into force on Monday 24th June 2016.

2. In this Order –

“the motorway” means the southbound carriageway of the M42 (adjacent to the M6 Toll) from a point 80 metres north of the centreline of Marsh Lane overbridge, to a point 400 metres north of the centreline of the B4114 Birmingham Road overbridge;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 27th June 2016 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) being used by, or at the direction of, a traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (d) being used in connection with the works.
