The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (St. Thomas Head, Weston-super-Mare) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2017

Made - - - at 16:00 hours on 29th January 2017 Coming into force - - with immediate effect

The Secretary of State, for a reason affecting the public interest, has deemed it necessary to restrict flying in the vicinity of St. Thomas Head, Weston-super-Mare by reason of an emergency having arisen there.

That emergency having now passed, the Secretary of State no longer deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in that area and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 161 of the Air Navigation Order $2016(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (St. Thomas Head, Weston-super-Mare) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2017 and come into force with immediate effect.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (St. Thomas Head, Weston-super-Mare) (Emergency) Regulations 2017(**b**) are revoked.
