The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Parsons Green, London) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2017

Made---at 11:20 hours on 16th September 2017Coming into force--with immediate effect

The Secretary of State previously decided that it was necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Parsons Green, London by reason of an emergency having arisen there.

That emergency having now passed, the Secretary of State has decided that it is no longer necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in that area and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order $2016(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Parsons Green, London) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2017 and come into force with immediate effect.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Parsons Green, London) (Emergency) Regulations 2017(**b**) are revoked.
