In exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966(1) ("the Act"), the Council of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons have made the Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 2018 ("the Regulations") set out in the Schedule to this Order.

By virtue of section 25(1) of the Act, the Regulations do not have effect unless approved by order of the Privy Council.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 25(1) and (2) of the Act, their Lordships make the following Order.

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations Order of Council 2018 and comes into force on 1st April 2018.

Approval

2. The Regulations set out in the Schedule are approved.

The Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 2018

The Council of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons, in exercise of its powers under section 11 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966, makes the following Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order approves the Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 2018 made by the Council of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons ("RCVS") under section 11 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966 on 18th January 2018. Those

Regulations substitute a new Part 4 of the Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners (Registration) Regulations 2014 ("the 2014 Regulations") (SI 2014/3493).

The new Part 4 of the 2014 Regulations, which takes effect from 1st April 2018, provides for an increase of approximately 5% in the fees for registration and retention of names in the Register of the RCVS.

No impact assessment has been produced for this instrument.
