# The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Hampden Stadium) (Amendment) Regulations 2021

 Made
 28th May 2021

 Coming into force
 14th June 2021

The Secretary of State has previously decided that it is in the public interest to restrict the flying of unmanned aircraft in the vicinity of Hampden Football Stadium, Glasgow, by reason of the holding of football matches associated with the UEFA Euro 2020 football championship.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Hampden Stadium) (Amendment) Regulations 2021(**b**) and they come into force on 14th June 2021.

### Amendment

- **2.**—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Hampden Stadium) Regulations 2021 are amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 3 paragraph 1(b) for "1400 hours and 1700 hours" substitute "1400 hours and 1900 hours".
- (3) In regulation 3 paragraph 1(d) for "1700 hours and 2200 hours" substitute "1700 hours and 2259 hours".
