The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal St George's Golf Course) (Amendment) Regulations 2021

The Secretary of State has previously decided that it is in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Royal St George's Golf Course, Sandwich, Kent, by reason of the intended holding of the 2021 Open Golf Championship which is scheduled to take place there.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal St George's Golf Course) (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and they come into force on 11th July 2021.

Amendment

- **2.**—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal St George's Golf Course) Regulations 2021(**b**) are amended as follows.
 - (2) In regulation 3 paragraph 1 for "521628N" substitute "511628N".
