The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (Amendment) Regulations 2021

 Made
 1st June 2021

 Coming into force
 4th June 2021

The Secretary of State has previously decided that it is in the public interest to restrict flying by reason of the intended holding of flying displays by a jet formation display team.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and come into force on 4th June 2021.

Amendment to the Regulations

- **2.**—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) Regulations 2021(**b**) are amended as follows.
 - (2) In the Schedule—
 - (a) omit the following entries in the respective columns—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) Regulations 2021 (S.I. 2021/536) which restrict flying in the vicinity of places where jet formation display teams intend to give certain flying displays.

The Regulations remove the displays scheduled to take place at Newcastle Northern Ireland (19th June 2021), Teignmouth (3rd July 2021), Wales National Show (3rd and 4th July 2021), Honington (22nd July 2021), Dawlish (18th August 2021), and Rhyl (28th and 29th August 2021).

These Regulations also add displays to be held at Headcorn (26th and 27th June 2021), Folkestone (8th August 2021), and Falmouth (11th August 2021).

Full details of this amendment will be promulgated by Notice to Airmen (NOTAM).
