# The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal Air Force Mildenhall) (Amendment) Regulations 2021

Made - - - at 11.40 a.m. on 9th June 2021

Coming into force - - with immediate effect

The Secretary of State has previously decided that it is in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of RAF Mildenhall, Suffolk, by reason of the intended visit by a Head of State.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal Air Force Mildenhall) (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and they come into force with immediate effect.

### Interpretation

**2.** In regulation 3(1) the times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time(**b**).

## Amendment to the Regulations

- **3.**—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal Air Force Mildenhall) Regulations 2021(**c**) are amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 3 paragraph 1 for "1830 hours and 2100 hours on 9th June 2021" substitute "1830 hours and 2130 hours on 9th June 2021".

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal Air Force Mildenhall) Regulations 2021 (S.I. 2021/683). They amend the specific timings for the visit of a Head of State.

The times mentioned in regulations 3(2) are Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).
