# **CIVIL AVIATION**

The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stansted and Central London) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations 2023

Made - - - - 30th October 2023

Coming into force - - 31st October 2023

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to amend the specific timings of the flying restrictions in Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stansted and Central London) (No. 2) Regulations 2023(a).

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(**b**).

### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stansted and Central London) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations 2023 and they come into force on 31st October 2023.

## **Amendment of the Regulations**

- **2.**—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stansted and Central London) (No. 2) Regulations 2023 are amended as follows.
  - (2) In regulation 3—
    - (a) in paragraph (1), for "2200 hours and 2300 hours" substitute "1945 hours and 2115 hours",
    - (b) in paragraph (2), for "2200 hours and 2300 hours" substitute "2015 hours and 2115 hours", and
    - (c) in paragraph (4), for "2200 hours" substitute "2015 hours".
