The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Old Buckenham) Regulations 2024

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the area specified in regulation 3(1) by reason of the intended holding there of flying displays.

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order $2016(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Old Buckenham) Regulations 2024 and they come into force on 27th July 2024.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) the times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time(**b**).

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1100 hours and 1800 hours on each day of 27th July 2024 and 28th July 2024 no aircraft is to fly below 10,300 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 5 nautical miles centred at 522951N 0010307E.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft—

- (a) operated by or on behalf of the—
 - (i) National Police Air Service,
 - (ii) Helicopter Emergency Medical Services, or
 - (iii) Maritime and Coastguard Agency, or
- (b) flying with the permission of the Old Buckenham Airshow flying display director.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in the vicinity of Old Buckenham Aerodrome, Norfolk during flying displays that are due to take place there on 27th July 2024 and 28th July 2024.

A large number of aircraft will be involved in high energy manoeuvres during the displays and therefore the Civil Aviation Authority and the Department for Transport agree that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the displays for reasons of public safety.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(2)(b), the Old Buckenham Airshow flying display director may be contacted as notified.

Full details of this Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular (AIC) and Notice to Aviation (NOTAM).
