# AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNITED KINGDOM AND STAM RELATIVE TO the REGIS'LRATION OF BRITISH SUBJECTS IN SIAM. 

Signed at liangkok, November 29, 1899.

The Govermments of "Her Majesty the Queen of the United Kingdom of Grent Britrin and Ireland, Empress of India, and of His Majesty the King of Siam, recognizing the necessity of having a satisfactory arrangement for the registration of liritish subjects in Siam, the Undersigned, Her Britamic Majesty's Minister Resident and His Siamese Majesty's Minister for Foreign Affairs, duly authorized to that effect, have agreed as follows:-

## I.

The registration according to Article V of the Treaty of April 18,1855 , of British subjects residing in Siam, shall comprise the following categories:
(1.) All British natural born or naturazed subjects, other than those of Asiatic descent.
(2.) All chikdren and grandchildren born in Sian of persons entitled to be registered under the first category, who are entitled to the status of Jritish subjects in contemplation of English law.

Neither great-grandchildren nor illegitimate children born in Siam of persons mentioned in the first category are entitled to be registered.
(3.) All persons of Asiatic descent, bom within the Quecn's dominions, or natumazed within the United Kingdom, or bom within the territory of any Prince or State in India under the suzerainty of, or in alliance with, the Queen.

Except natives of Upper Jimmah or the Jritish Shan States who became domiciled in Siam before January 1st, 1886.
(4.) All children born in Siam of persons entitled to be registered under the third category.

No grandchildren born in Siam of persons mentioned in the third category are entitled to be registered for protection in Siam.
(5.) The wives and witlows of any persons who are entitled to be registered under the foregoing categories.

## II.

The lists of such registration slall be open to the inspection of a properly authorized tiepresentative of the Siamese Govermuent on proper notice being given.

## liI.

If any question arises as to the right of any person to hold a British certificate of registration or as to the validity of the certifieate itsolf, a joint inquiry shall be held by the British and Siamese anthorities and ilecided according to the conditions haid down in this Agreement, upon evidence to be alduced by the holler of the certificate, in the usnal way.

Shonld any action, civil or criminal, be pending while such inquiry is going on, it sliall be determined conjointly in what Court the ease shall be heard.

## V.

It the person, in respect of whom the inquiry is held, come within the conditions for registration laid down in Article I, he may, if not yet registered, forthwith be registered as a British sulject and provided with a certificate of registration at Her Jritamic Majesty's Consulate; otherwise he shall be recognizel as falling under Siamese jurisdiction. and, if already on the lists of Her Britannic Majesty's Consulate, his nane shall he crased.

In witness whereof the Undersigned have signed the same in duplicaterand have affixed thereto thicir seals at Bangkok, on the 29th day of November, 1899, of the Christion era, corresponding to the 118th year of Ratamakosinds.
