His Majesty the King of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, Emperor of India, and the United States of America, finding it expedient to prolong for a period of twelve months the time fixed by Article IV of the Convention relative to the disposal of real and personal property, signed at Washington on the 2nd day of March, 1899, for the notification of their accession to that Convention by His Britannic Majesty's Colonies or foreign possessions have agreed to conclude an additional Convention for that purpose, and have named as their Plenipotentiaries:

His Majesty the King of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, Emperor of India, the Right Honourable Lord Pauncefote of Preston, G.C.B., G.C.M.G., His Majesty's Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the United States; and the President of the United States of America, the Honourable John Hay, Secretary of State of the United States of America; who, having communicated to each other their full powews, which were found to be in due and proper form, have agreed upon the following sole Article:

SOLE ARTICLE.

It is agreed that the time fixed in Article IV of the said Convention, within which the accessions thereto of His Britannic Majesty's Colonies or foreign possessions shall be notified, shall be prolonged for a period of twelve months from July 28th, 1901.

In faith whereof the respective Plenipotentiaries have signed this Convention, and hereunto affixed their seals.

Done in duplicate at Washington, the 13th day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and two.
