Sir E. Grey to the Swiss Minister.

Sir, Foreign Office, November 3, 1909.

I HAVE the honour to inform you that His Majesty's Government are prepared to renew, for a period of five years from the date of its expiration, the Arbitration Agreement concluded between His Britannic Majesty's Government and the Federal Council of the Swiss Confederation on the 16th November, 1904, on the understanding that the Federal Council are equally prepared to agree to such renewal.

Should you agree to the proposed procedure, the present note and your reply will be regarded by His Majesty's Government as placing upon record the understanding arrived at between our respective Governments in the matter.

Sir, Swiss Legation, London, November 12, 1909.

WITH reference to the note which your Excellency was good enough to address to me on the 3rd instant, I have the honour to inform you that the Swiss Federal Council concur in the proposal of His Britannic Majesty's Government to renew for a further period of five years the Arbitration Agreement concluded between Switzerland and Great Britain on the 16th November, 1904, which is about to expire on the 16th instant.

My Government being of the same opinion as His Britannic Majesty's Government, that the renewal in question may be effected by an exchange of notes, I shall be obliged if you will consider the present note, with that of your Excellency referred to above, as duly giving effect to the understanding thus arrived at between our respective Governments.
